The ATIS DSM Technical Report (ATIS 0600007) provides the DSL Industry with guidelines for the use of Dynamic Spectrum Management (DSM) to optimize DSL services. DSM techniques significantly improve the speed and stability of DSL services by managing interference and crosstalk, ensuring DSL's continued competitiveness with other broadband access techniques. DSM is thus a key enabler for new broadband services such as DVD-quality IPTV.
